## Proposal for Partnership and Funding: Personified Tree Planting (PTP) Project

After the successful launch of the Ghana Chapter of the Global Alliance for Technologies in Nature Conservation (GAfTiNC), we are excited to introduce to you one of our innovative projects, the Personified Tree Planting (PTP) project. In collaboration with our partners, we aim to encourage individuals and institutions to plant trees and tag their personal details to foster a sense of responsibility and contribution to environmental conservation.

## **Project Overview:**

The system can also export data into Keyhole Markup Language (KML) format for geographical display of nursery and planted trees on Google Earth. The second version of the system intends to calculate the above-ground biomass with monitoring and ground truthing data for carbon assessment. GAfTiNC intends to make this system available for use to pilot it, and offer training for institutions and individuals to use the system effectively.

# Project Objectives:

- To promote tree planting as a means of environmental conservation and climate change mitigation measure.
- To engage individuals and institutions in taking responsibility for their environmental impact through tree planting.
- To create a digital platform for tracking and monitoring tree-planting activities and their associated contributors.
